Chairman, by the November meeting. An alternative to requesting that you be nominated by the Nominating Committee is to present a petition to the Nominating Chairman at or before the November meeting. Petition requirements follow:

Nominations for officer or trustee may also be made by petition, signed by the candidate, and delivered to the Chairman of the Nominating Committee, or in his absence to the Superintendent, signed by ten (10) members of the division at or prior to the November Division Meeting. The signatures must be legible and the member's NMRA membership number and expiration date must appear with the signature. The petition shall state what office the candidate is seeking nomination. No candidate can be nominated for more than one office in any election.

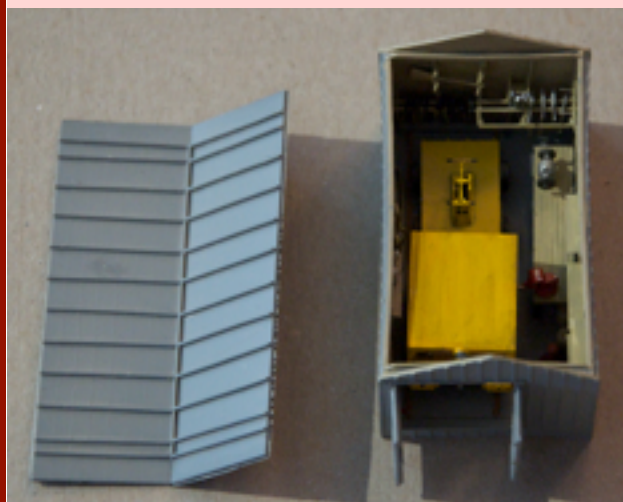

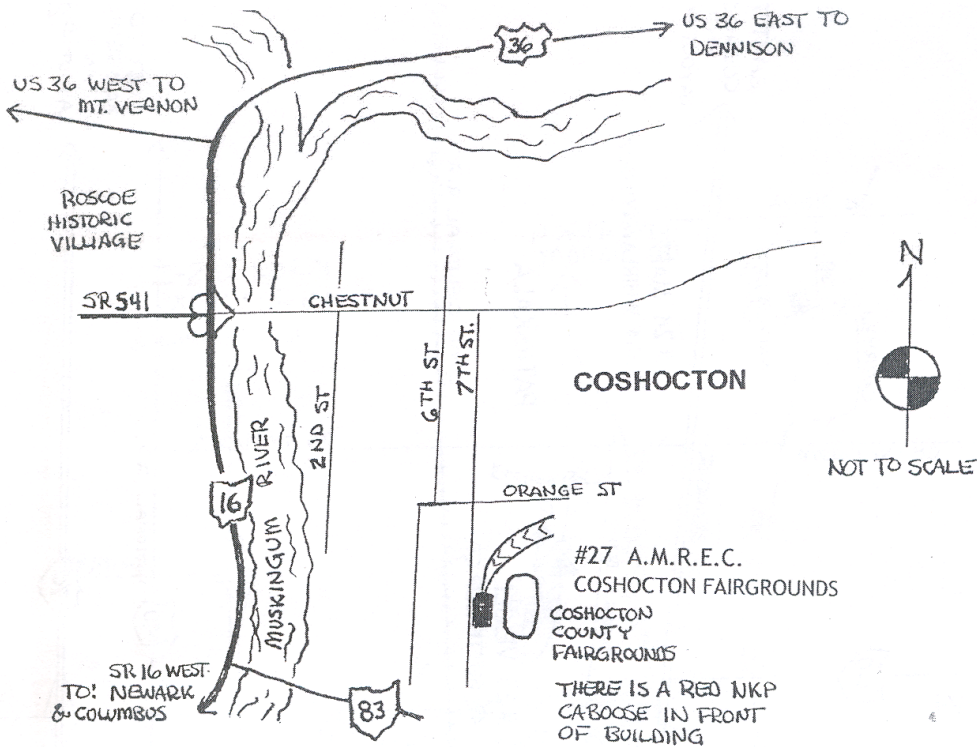
