Superintendent's Report

Fall officially arrived on Saturday, September 22, summer is long gone and it's time to do some serious Model Railroading. Clean the cobwebs off the layout and finish that building from last spring or add some detail you have been thinking about.

I attended the fall Mid-Central Region Board of Directors Meeting on September 23 here in Columbus. We had a great meeting and the food was good, as usual. We got an update on the 2013 MCR Convention. to be held in Dayton, Ohio, May 15-18, 2013, also the 2014 NMRA National Convention. in Cleveland, Ohio, and Lexington, Kentucky will host the 2015 MCR Convention.

All U.S. Region and Division boundaries are now defined by state and county boundaries, rather than zip codes. This will help keep boundaries stable as the U.S. Post Office continues to redefine its zip code areas.

Michiana Division cofounder, Jim Six, a college professor and experienced educa-

tion expert, has agreed to lead a team charged with developing a standardized clinic format that will help ensure consistency and uniformity for clinics made to available to divisions and regions.

The NMRA Standards & Conformance Department directed that all eight DCC-related Recommended Practices now become NMRA Standards.

The attendance of the *National Train Show* in Grand Rapids, Michigan was the fourth best ever.

The Peachtree Express, 2013 NMRA National Convention., team reports that it's putting the finishing touches on a series of short videos featuring selected layouts that will be on tour during the National Convention in Atlanta, Georgia in 2013. The meeting started with Division 9 Superintendent Weinheimer asking everyone to stand and introduce themselves to the group.

Clerk's Report: John Gafney. After Super Weinheimer gave the Division 9 Report, John said the Division 6 Clerk's Report was in the September issue of the *Super's Signal*. He asked for comments, and there were none.

Paymaster's Report: John Gafney. John said the Paymaster's Report was in the September issue of the *Super's Signal* after Bob Weinheimer gave the Division 9 Finical Report.

John Baker: Bob Weinheimer. The recent passing of John Baker, a former member of Division 6, was noted. It was remembered that John was an avid youth partici-

The discussion was preceded by Bob Weinheimer discussion of the Division 9 newsletter, *Up The Holler*.

Marion Meeting: Bob Weinheimer. Bob reported that Division 9 had more members present at the joint Marion Meeting than Division 6, but the clinics were great, the train watching was better, and the fellowship was the best.

Cincinnati Bus Trip: A brief description of the recent Cincinnati Bus Trip was given. The trip to *Entertrainment*. *Junction*, and *Cincinnati Union Terminal* was described.

Hocking Valley Railroad: Bob Weinheimer. Division 9 is planning a trip to the *Hocking Valley Railroad*, possibly next June, and has invited Division 6 members to join them. Details to follow.

Golden Spike Awards - 4 total, 1 from Division 6

Program/Contest Notes

Bill Connell, Program Chair John Retterer, Contest Chair

Change, is the one thing you can count on; it is with us every day, and yet it is one of the most difficult parts of our lives to accept. Everything around us is changing constantly, in some small or perhaps large way, and typically without warning.

What has this to do with the division-meeting format and program? Everything. The change in the contest format and judging required a readjustment of the division meeting agenda to accommodate the new contest format. Time is needed to judge the contest entries, find qualified judges for the contest, and limit time for entries to the contest; this will allow adequate time to judge the models.

Starting with the January 2013 Division 6 Meeting at the *Columbus Model Railroad Club*, some changes in the Division 6 program and contest start to take effect. We present the first change this month.

Model Contest Format

The Contest Chair continues to set a theme for the contest just as before; but, contest judging is no longer based on Popular Vote. It is based on judged score of models that are either: Kit Built, Kit Bashed, or Scratch Built. The January Contest is Kit Built models. A kit Built model is not a 'blue box' model, but a 'quality' model, for example, a laser kit.

Please understand, your Kit Built model can include scratch built parts, but the contest is about building the KIT, not the scratch built parts. Each entry is judged using the MCR Contest Judging Form, and points are awarded following those standards. The form will be printed in future issues of the *Super's Signal* and will be found on the Division 6 WEB Site.

Contest Categories

The realignment of model judging contest categories was the result of what other regions and divisions are doing, and our desire to open up the judging to a more general alignment.

The new categories are broad based and include: Freight or revenue producing cars, Passenger Cars, Military Cars, Non-revenue Cars, Motive Power, Structures, Displays, and Modules. Additional information about each category will be printed in a future issue of the *Super's Signal*.

Yes, the Popular Vote Contest for models continues, but the results do not count in selecting the Modeler of the Year. That is the function of the judged model contest.

A.P. Contest

The changes in the contest format and the feed back it provides is to encourage division members to bring their entries back to the Annual AP Contest at Marion. However, AP Chair, Howard Smith, is willing to judge any model, with proper paper work, at any division meeting we have a contest, room permitting.

Remember a score of 87 1/2 points or greater, suggests the model is worthy of an AP Merit Award. Take the time required to fill out the appropriate Achievement Program forms for the judging at

Marion in June, perhaps in November or at the next division meeting. You did the hard work, building the model. So take one more step, and earn the model an AP Merit award.

Photo Contest

Changes to the Photo Contest judging will be put off till 2014, pending the development of a judging criteria.

2013 Contests


Kit Bashed models are on tap for the April 2013 meeting, and Scratch Built models in June. Remember, June is also the time for AP judging. Get busy and build the models you wish to enter for judging, following the: Kit Built, Kit Bashed, Scratch Built contest plan.

Note: These plans are still in a state of flux, and changes to the contest format and/or judging may occur. Additional information will be in future issues of the *Super's Signal*.

Clinics

I have lined up a couple of live clinics, one for January, another for April. But, that is it; nothing for the remainder of the year. I thought June was coming together; but, as of now, that appears to have fallen a part. It is hard to find anyone who lives in the division to present a clinic, not already presented several times in the past. The issue is simple. The topics were covered several times; the presenter is not available, or because of mobility problems, is no longer able to get around. When the program is short on a clinic presenter, I hope to have a video clinic, perhaps from one of the clinics offered at an NMRA convention.

Anyone who would like to present a clinic, this is the time to step up, earn some points for either an Author or a Volunteer an AP certificate.


