## 2013 Contests

John Retterer, Contest Chair

We've made some changes for the 2013 contests. There will be five contests in 2013.

1. At the January 27 meeting at the Columbus Model Railroad Club, the Model Contest is Revenue (Freight) Cars. The Photo Contest is Unique Revenue Cars. Revenue Cars are as described in the November 2012 *Super's Signal*.
2. At the April 7 meeting at the Saint John's Lutheran Church, in Grove City, the Model Contest is Locomotives. The Photos Contest is Locomotives.
3. At the June 15 meeting at Marion Union Station, the Model Contest is the largest contest event of the year. Motive Power is the main theme. Small Modules (Dioramas), no larger than 24 x 48 inches are recommended. The Photo Contest is also Motive Power. Additional, AP judging will be available. It is the individual's responsibility to contact the AP Chair, Howard Smith, MMR, to make the necessary preparations and do the paperwork.
4. At the October 13 meeting at Canal Winchester, the Model Contest is Non-Revenue Cars. The Photo Contest is the same. The Non-Revenue Cars are as described in the November 2012 *Super's Signal*.
5. The final contest for the year is the November 17 meeting at the Coshocton Model Railroad Club. The Model Contest is Structures as described in the

November 2012 *Super's Signal*. The Photo Contest is Unusual Structures.

The models are judged at the meetings and forms will be there. Before you panic, the only thing you, the builder, is required to fill out is your name and address with a brief description of what you modeled. By so doing, the Judges know what you intended. The Judges prepare the remainder of the form. A numeric score is applied to each criterion judged. Comments will be made to help you improve your modeling skills.

The categories are:

1. Construction Techniques, 0-20 points.
2. Detail, 0-10 points.
3. Conformity, 0-10 points.
4. Finish and lettering, 0-10 points.
5. Scratch built, if applicable, 0-10 points.

We intend to assist you as much as possible to develop your modeling skills. We realize the majority of you are very accomplished modelers and your input is very valuable. The new modelers need and want guidance with their modeling; I hope all will participate in this program to help other modelers.

These are quotes from Bob Bowditch's *Model Railroad Rules To Live By*: "Do overs are a way of life in this hobby. The objective is to have fun."

## Leo Campbell

*from Campbell Scale Models Online November 2012 Newsletter*

“Leo Campbell, the founder of Campbell Scale Models passes away at 85: What can be said ... Leo is the reason why Campbell Scale Models exists today.

Back in the 1950s, Leo was a painter for Walt Disney in Anaheim, California and an avid railroader and model maker. His interests crossed paths with Tom Ayers, well know for his designs in model making and marketing. Loe and Tom struck-up a friendship and worked closely together in planning Leo's new craftsman model company Campbell Scale Models (circa 1960) in Santa Ana California.

Leo and his wife, Ruth, purchased a few of Tom Ayers' model designs and Tom also assisted in marketing Campbell Scale Models (CSM) in the early years. In the 1970s, CSM grew to have over a dozen employees as their products were marketed by a number of wholesalers and distributors. Disillusioned by the business climate in

southern California, Leo and Ruth moved their company to Durango Colorado in 1991. The modeling industry saw a slow down after 2000 with a significant drop in sales. Leo and Ruth worked closely with Duncan Campbell, a close friend who had successfully run a number of his own companies, to bring CSM back to profitability. In 2004, Duncan Campbell purchased Campbell Scale Models from Leo and Ruth and moved it to southern Oregon, in Center Point.

Leo's influence and mentorship will be greatly missed at CSM and his passing is a great loss to the modeling industry in general. Please hold Ruth and her family in your thoughts and prayers.

Leo, as a decorated U.S. Marine from WWII, was laid to rest with full military honors at the Western Colorado Veterans Memorial Cemetery in Grand Junction Colorado.”

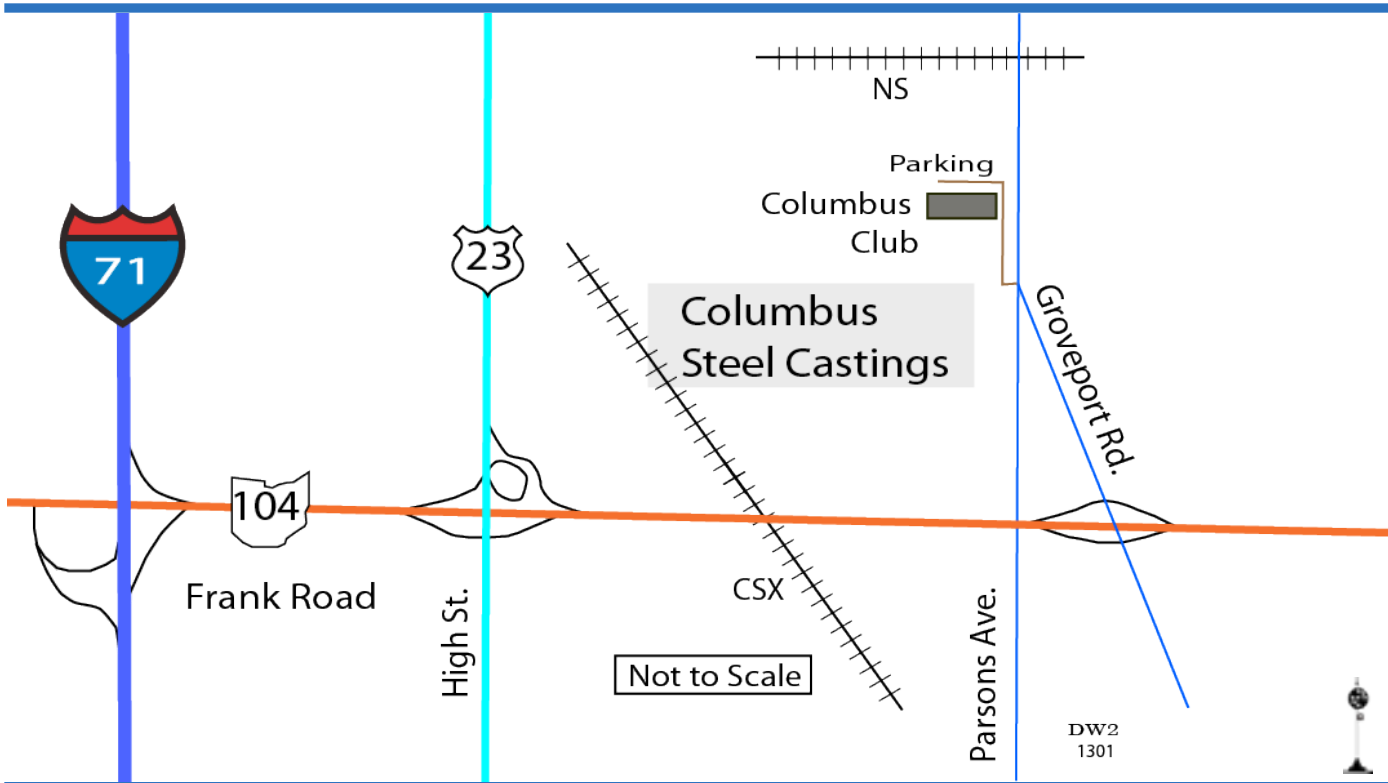
