The tour is fascinating, from the wonderful sounds the mechanical DC relays make as the route is being lined, to the over-my-head DC controls, to the great scenery. The crazy loop in the mountain was especially interesting as the train stalled momentarily going upgrade, and wheeled crazily downhill at breakneck speeds going the opposite direction. It's a fun watch, even if it was in the dark.

Dear Division 6 member,


