

The intent of the Division 6 Hobby Shop Program is two fold.

- A. The first intent is to give Division 6 members a incentive to attend Division 6 Meetings.

HOW IT WILL WORK.

The program will be arranged in such a way that all Division 6 members will have their name printed on a ticket. All the tickets will be placed in a sealed container. Once during each Division 6 meeting a ticket will be drawn for the container. **IF** the division member whose ticket has been drawn is in attendance **AND** has their Division 6 issued name tag on, that member will be given a certificate for a discount at any participating hobby shop as listed on the division website. 


